Guest speaker - Azmen Johnson, Lead Facilitator of Prescriptions for Repair (P4R)

- P4R is a 1 year pilot project launched in 2022 with combined support of the City of Durham, Duke, and NCCU to listen to Durham residents who have been impacted by gun violence in Durham. Azmen is responsible for coordinating the necessary listening sessions of survivor participants in addition to reporting updates to the City of Durham. She is excited to share a brief overview of the program, explain what the "restorative approach" is, and offer ways for Trinity Park residents to stay connected and engaged.
- Listen and hear what gun violence victims and families need to heal and to make things right with a restorative justice framework for healing and repair.
- Participant's can have up to 4 sessions and receive \$25/hr for their time and wisdom. Sessions have 2 facilitators and a survivor.
- Have met with 32 survivors/participants and plan to serve 40 survivors.
