**GUEST SPEAKER - John Hodges-Copple**, retired planner with Triangle J Council of Governments and TP neighbor, on the subject of gaining local control over the one-way streets, including Duke and Gregson

- Currently Duke, Gresgson, Vickers, Mangum (about 14 lane miles) are state maintained roads- state gets to decide how they are designed, speed limit etc. State also maintains (stripes, paves, etc).
- City and States trade roads often. Trading Duke and Gregson for a different road. John suggests trading MLK Jr parkway (15 lane miles)
- John thinks the state and city would be open since the connector is open.
- Who do we need to convince / What is the process- The city would likely need to initiate to the state. Awaiting a response to the rest of the process from state and city.
- The city would decide what they would want to change- 1 way to 2 way, stop lights, signs, parking. John thinks it would be more like Buchanan and Broad Streets.
- Do we consider doing a poll to the neighborhood? How do we want to include the neighborhood? There are also other neighborhoods that this would affect outside Trinity Park and we want to include the other neighborhoods. We will let the traffic committee take the lead.
